### Registration for the 2010-2011 School Year

#### Pre-School & Kindergarten

Sts. Peter & Paul School will hold its pre-school and kindergarten registration on Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup> and will be held in the school science lab. Current pre-school and kindergarten students are not to report to school on this day.

Registration begins at 9:00 a.m. and will last until 3:00 p.m. Returning students/current families are welcome to begin registering starting at 8:15 a.m. The county will also be having their kindergarten/pre-school screenings that day at Oak Hill High School from 8:30 – 2:30. These screenings provide parents with information related to their child's development in the areas of hearing, vision, speech, language, fine and gross motor skills, social/emotional and cognition.

Returning parents enrolling a pre-school or kindergarten student that would like to enroll their other children in grades 1-8 may also enroll those students on that date.

A \$100 non-refundable cash deposit is required for all students in grades pre-school and kindergarten.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grades

Registration will be open to returning families/students until Monday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. After that date, registration for the 2010-2011 school year will be open to the public and students will be enrolled on a first-come, first-served basis.
