Parishioners of Sts. Peter & Paul Parish,

It is with mixed feelings that I write this letter to you. Earlier this week I made the announcement to the entire school community that I will be resigning my position as principal of the school in order to accept the position of Institutional Advancement Director.

I will continue my duties as principal until a new principal has been hired.

The duties of Advancement Director include grant writing; enrollment recruitment and retention; fundraising; and cultivating relationships with the school's sponsors, donors, and alumni. In addition to the duties of Advancement Director, I will continue teaching religion to grades 2-4 (and begin teaching 1st) and I will continue many of my current bookkeeping responsibilities.

As many of you know, Bishop Bransfield has made a concerted effort to help the schools of our diocese create a plan where each school has a full-time advancement director on staff. The Diocese has hired an advancement company, Partners in Mission, as consultants to help facilitate this process.

It is my hope that by taking this step, Sts. Peter & Paul School will solidify its future on the Plateau and continue its mission of bringing Jesus Christ to the children of Fayette County for years to come.

I would like to thank the entire parish community for their support during my time as principal and I look forward to continuing my service to you as Advancement Director.

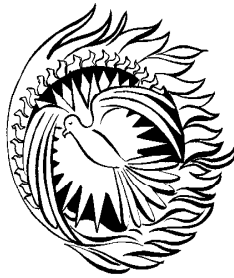
