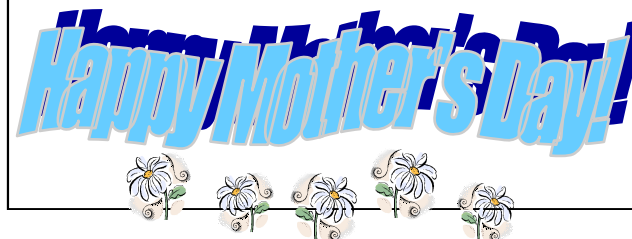


2010 Parish Summer Day Camp Program
